What will it cost to educate my child at St. Aloysius Catholic School?

Total cost to educate each child.....\$6,500

Additionally, the following fees will apply to each child:

One-Time Fees per Child, PK-8 :

Registration	(Due by May 11 th).....	\$45
Instructional Materials and Software Licensure:	(Due by Aug. 3rd).....	\$110
Technology:	(Due by Aug. 3rd).....	\$300
Student Insurance (K-8) = \$40 / (PK) = \$30:	(Due by Aug. 3rd)	\$40/\$30
Total fees per PK child = \$475		Total fees per child, K-8 = \$495

Aid and Grants:

There are opportunities for financial aid available to you depending on eligibility including School Choice Scholarships from the State of Indiana, grants from the Scholarship Granting Organization of Northeast Indiana, needs-based scholarships, and the Active Registered Parishioner status. Nearly 70% of our families receive some kind of needs-based assistance. If you would like to meet in person to discuss your family's needs, please contact the principal.

Families who anticipate receiving School Choice Scholarship, a grant from the SGO, or additional parish support, must provide your 2016 tax return in order to establish eligibility. You will be required to create an account with F.A.C.T.S. Grant and Aid.

Pre-Kindergarten Program Choices – (% refers to tuition only - not fees)

- 3 half days (T, W, Th a.m.) - 26% of child or of ARP youngest enrolled sibling.
- 5 half days (a.m. only) – 43% of child or of ARP youngest enrolled sibling.
- 3 full days (T, W, Th) - 60% of child or of ARP youngest enrolled sibling.
- 5 full days – 90% of child or of ARP youngest enrolled sibling.

Note: There may be other options depending on the configurations of enrollment.
