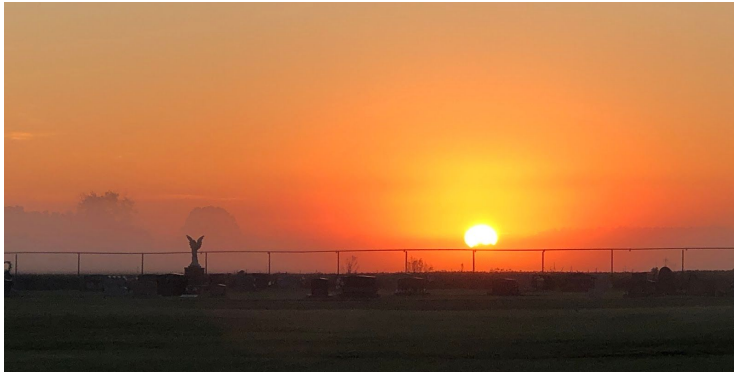


Gator Goings-On, August 20th, 2020
