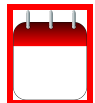

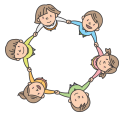


**SCHEDULE UPDATE: Feb. 12 and 15, 2021: NO SCHOOL either day**

**Spring Break** is scheduled for April 5th through the 9th, 2021. The prior Friday, April 2nd is **Good Friday** with NO school.



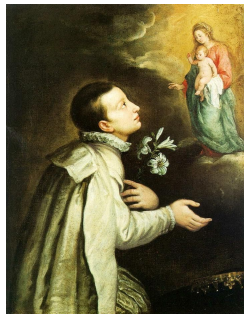
